- 8 The **Surf** is always up in Lahinch, a very popular seaside resort just a ten minute drive from the majestic Cliffs of Moher. Boasting a world famous 2km Blue Flag beach, this is the ideal place to put **Water Sports** enthusiasts through their paces.
