Only 6 hours from the United States East Coast, 2 hours from mainland Europe and 45 minutes from Great Britain.

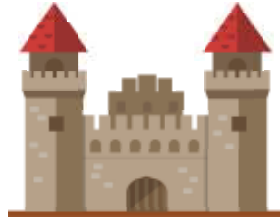
WILD ATLANTIC WAY
